**REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS**

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (c), I wish to request a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Transport and Public Works regarding non-functioning street lights in the County.

Hon. Speaker, street and public lights are an important component of day-to-day operations of Wards, especially facilitation of conduct of business and movement of good, people and services. The country is, by policy, moving towards 24-hour economy and the activities and principles that will drive this initiative successfully are partially depended on proper street/public lights. Specifically, in Woodley Ward, the following areas have been in darkness and need urgent County intervention to ensure lighting is restored:

- 1) Harlequins roads;
- 2) Wamagate;
- 3) Fort Jesus;
- 4) Chrisco;
- 5) Jamhuri Phase I and II;
- 6) Toi Primary School road;
- 7) Digo road;
- 8) Muvaa Groove;
- 9) Jamhuri Amani Court; and
- 10) Woodly/Jamhuri Market.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement the Chairperson should inquire into and report on:

1. The measures being put in place by the County Executive to have the street and public lights in the aforementioned areas restored; and
2. The steps the County Executive is taking to ensure that street/public lights installed by the County in the Ward and across the County are in working condition to curb cases of insecurity and promote business during night hours.
