REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (c), I wish to request a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Planning and Housing and the Select Committee on County Finance, Budget and Appropriations regarding revenue collected from advertisements and billboards in the County, specifically those on Jogoo and Langata roads.

Hon. Speaker, as per the provisions of the Nairobi City County Finance Act, advertisements and billboards are among the key revenue streams for the County and it is critical that investors in billboards and advertisements remit the requisite fees to the County as per the law because the County partly depends on the collections to undertake development in the interest of the residents of the County.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement the Chairperson should inquire into and report on:

1. The number and list of Billboards approved by the County for erection along the said roads;
2. The amount of revenue collected form the billboards during the FY 2018/2019; and
3. Steps being taken by the County Executive to ensure that investors remit to the County requisite charges and that action is taken on those who evade payment of the said charges.
