REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Subject: Rampant Demotion, suspension or sacking of staff of Nairobi City County Government.

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Roads, Transport and Public Works regarding the operations of County vehicle fleet and related Departments that rely on the said fleet to undertake their mandates.

Hon. Speaker, there have been complaints from officers of the County Executive who rely on the County Governments fleet to undertake their jobs over the unavailability of the County vehicles and the poor state of some of the said vehicles. It is not clear how many vehicles the County owns or has leased and whether such vehicles have been put to their proper use.

Hon. Speaker, there are allegations of impropriety on the management, control and assignment of County vehicles to various departments, occasioning serious delays to service delivery at the sub-county and ward levels. The result is that the County is spending millions of money on maintenance and purchase of new vehicles when other alternatives such as leasing could serve the purpose.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i) The total number of the County’s owned vehicle fleet, detailing their status and where assigned and the names of the respective officers assigned said vehicles;
- ii) Whether the County has leased any vehicles or entered any leasing agreements with any providers; and if yes,
- iii) Documents detailing the tender process by which the said providers were identified and awarded the leasing contracts and at how much;
- iv) Number of vehicles currently under any such lease agreement, their status and assignment; and
- v) Documents relating to tender and or contracts for the repair and maintenance of County vehicles, including record of all payments made to such garages or said entities for maintenance of County fleet since September, 2017.
