REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (c), I wish to request a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Labour and Social Welfare regarding the ongoing recruitment of Health Sector staff in the County.

Hon. Speaker, the Health Sector is an important organ of the County Government and anchored in the H.E The President's Big Four Agenda as well as H.E The Governor's Big Eight Agenda for the County. The President and the Governor have separately pronounced themselves against acts of corruption and need for government officers to uphold the rule of law.

Hon. Speaker, the County Government is concluding the process of recruitment of Health Sector staff to serve at the various health facilities in the County and the process has been marred with allegations of bribery and lacking due process.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement the Chairperson should inquire into and report on:

1. The criteria and process being used by the County for recruitment for the position of the said staff in the County;
2. Whether due process is being followed in the recruitment process; and
3. Why the process should not be halted to allow for a fair recruitment exercise.
