REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Transport and Public Works regarding dilapidated state of several roads and improvement drainage systems in the County and more specifically in Parklands/Highridge Ward.

Hon. Speaker, several roads and drainage systems in Parklands/Highridge Ward are rendered impassable during rainy seasons to point that members of the public have cartooned the roads on social media as swimming pools and fishing ponds due to their dilapidated state. For example, Mtama Road off 5th Avenue has big potholes which are dangerous to motorists. The issue has been raised with the relevant County Department but nothing has been done to date.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- Reasons for delayed rehabilitation of the roads in Parklands/Highridge Ward especially Mtama Road and Eldama Ravine Road;
- ii) Commencement of the rehabilitation of the roads in Parklands/Highridge Ward especially Mtama Road and Eldama Ravine Road where the roads are impassable; and
- iii) Measures the County Executive is taking to ensure that roads and drainage systems rehabilitated within the shortest time possible to avert the looming floods in Parklands/Highridge Ward and the County in general.
