## REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Environment and Natural regarding garbage spilling in Nairobi County specifically in the central business district.

Hon. Speaker, recent past Nairobi has experienced increase in the garbage spill over in the streets. National solid waste management regulations of 2006, in line with Article 42 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 provides for a healthy, safe and secure environment for all. In order to achieve this, there should be supervision and coordination on the garbage collection in the County

Hon. Speaker, Solid waste management remains a major challenge in the county. This has led to the current poor waste management situation across the County. In an effort to address poor solid waste management, National Environment Management Authority (NEMA) developed some minimum requirements as a baseline for implementation by the County. These included designation, securing and manning of the disposal sites, promotion of efficient collection and transportation of waste. This Strategy will therefore build on the on-going waste management efforts towards the attainment of full compliance and ensuring a clean and healthy environment.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

i. Spillage of the garbage on the City Streets;

ii. Plans in place to collect garbage in markets such as Muthurwa, Marikiti and Kirinyaga road Shabir Centre holding ground;

iii. Measures the County Executive is taking to ensure there is clean and healthy environment not only in the CBD but the County at large.
