REQUEST FOR STATEMENT

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2)(c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Planning and Housing regarding ownership status of the County public lands in Riruta Ward, specifically the Jua Kali and the Riruta Cemetery lands.

Hon. Speaker. In planning law, a provision is made for guide lines (master plans) on allocation and designating public land for the construction or use of any public land for the purpose of benefiting the citizens.

Hon. Speaker, the case on alleged encroachment of land in Riruta ward by private developers is appalling and the County Government need to investigate into the matter.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i) The owner of the two pieces of land and their documentations thereof;
- ii) The original acreage of the lands that were allocated for the Cemetery and Jua kali artisans;
- iii) Whether the County Government has given any lease to private developers or other entities; and,
- iv) Steps that the County Government is taking to map out, revert and protect County Public Lands from perennial encroachment.
