REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Planning and Housing regarding the encroachment of road reserves by private developers in the County particularly in Kayole Central.

Hon. Speaker, recent years have experienced increased encroachment on public land especially road reserves by private developers in the County.

Hon. Speaker, the residents of Kayole Central Ward are undergoing undue suffering due to encroachment of road reserves by private developers who have erected fences along Diwopa Road near Bondeni Primary Schools and Kayole South Secondary Schools, making it difficult for pupils and students to access their schools on time.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i. Approval of construction of fences on road reserves along Diwopa Road;
- ii. Whether the Diwopa Road has been transferred from being a public road to a private road; and
- iii. Measures the County Executive is taking to deter private developers from interfering and encroaching on public roads in the County.
