REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Transport and Public works regarding the increasing incidences of insecurity in the County, particularly in Woodley Ward.

Hon. Speaker, cases of mugging at Dagoretti corner and its environs are on the upward surge and are now becoming the order of the day. Victims have been reporting such incidences to the Office of the Director of Criminal Investigation but there have been less outcome hence emboldening the perpetrators. The area near the defunct Nairobi City Council houses, for instance has become the hotspot of these criminal activities.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i) Efforts being made to have street lights installed at the defunct Nairobi City Council houses and along Joseph Kang'ethe road;
- ii) Measures being put in place to install high mast lights at water bowsers parking lot near Karandini market; and,
- iii) Measures the County Executive and Nairobi Metropolitan Service are putting in place to ensure proper lighting is provided in a timely manner to enhance security of the residents of the County.
