REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Subject: Access to Government Procurement Opportunities by Women, Youth and Persons With Disabilities

Hon. Speaker,


Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of Select Committee on Finance, Budget and Appropriations regarding the implementation of the Presidential directive on equitable access to government tendering.

Hon. Speaker, on 16th October 2013. H.E the President issued a migratory directive to government Ministries, Departments and Agencies; and County Governments to facilitate women, youth and persons with disabilities access to government procurement process under Access to Government Procurement Opportunities (AGPO). In the said directive, H.E the President directed that at least 30% of government tenders be set aside for the above-mentioned categories of people in light of Article 227 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010.

Hon. Speaker, this directive is binding to County Governments and as such it is imperative for the Nairobi City County to give an account of the milestones since 2013 when the order was issued

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i) Current status report on the implementation of the President's directive on access to 30% of government tenders since 2013 under AGPO, including lists of participating beneficiaries; and,
- ii) Steps that the Nairobi Metropolitan Services and County Executive is taking to foster and enhance participation of the said group of people in County Government tendering process
