## REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Subject: Report on the implementation of the Motion to establish Miraa Market in the County

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Select Committee on Implementation regarding the resolution of the County Assembly for the County Executive to set aside a special market for the commerce of Miraa similar to markets for farm produce, livestock, apparel among others.
