REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Subject: dropping and parking of Garbage Collection trucks within the County

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Environment Natural Resources regarding dropping and parking garbage collection trucks along Komarock and Muigai Roads in Dandora Area.

Hon. Speaker, Article 42 of the Constitution 2010 provides that every person has the right to a clean and healthy environment including the right to have the environment protected for the benefit of present and future generations through legislative and other measures. Additionally, Section 5 of the Nairobi City County Solid Waste Management Act, 2015 provides that every person within the County is entitled to a clean and healthy environment and has a duty to safeguard and enhance the quality of the environment.

Hon. Speaker, in recent weeks have witnessed garbage collection trucks dropping waste along Komarock and Muigai Roads on the way to the dumpsite. Further, the said trucks are always parked recklessly along the roads making it hard for other road users to navigate their way.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i. Measures the County Executive and the Nairobi Metropolitan are taking to ensure garbage collection trucks do not drop waste along the Komarock and Muigai Roads making the environment unhealthy for residents; and
- ii. Measures the County Executive and the Nairobi Metropolitan are taking to ensure garbage collection trucks are parked in an orderly manner to ease transport along Komarock and Muigai Roads and along the entrance to the dumpsite in Dandora.
