REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Subject: Lack of Vaccines at the Inoculation Centre, City Hall

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Health Services regarding lack of vaccines at the Inoculation Centre, located at City Hall.

Hon. Speaker, the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 provides for the right to the highest attainable standard of health including right to health care services. It is unfortunate that the Nairobi residents cannot access vaccinations including yellow fever at the County Inoculation Centre located at City Hall due to lack of vaccines.

Hon. Speaker, over five hundred residents seek vaccinations at the Centre in a day which translates to over five hundred thousand shillings per day. However, residents cannot access the services currently due to lack of vaccines and other necessary equipments.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i. Reasons for delay in supplying the necessary vaccines at the Inoculation Centre, City Hall;
- ii. Whether the Centre has a budget to operate on; and
- iii. Measures the County Executive and the Nairobi Metropolitan Services are taking to ensure the Centre is supplied with vaccines and other equipment necessary for seamless operation.
