Subject: Littering in the County and uneven distribution of County cleaners

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairpersons of Sectoral Committees on Labour and Social Welfare and Environment and Natural Resources regarding shortage and uneven distribution of County staff providing cleaning services in the Wards and garbage collection equipment in the County particularly in Umoja 1 Ward


Hon. Speaker, concerns have been raised regarding uneven distribution of County staff attached in various Wards to clean and collect piling garbage that has become a threat to the environment and health of residents in the County especially, in Eastlands and informal settlements. The foregoing concerns have led to pile up of garbage and blocked drainages in the Wards especially during the ongoing rainy season.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairpersons should inquire into and report on: -

- i) Reasons for the uneven distribution of County staff providing cleaning and sanitation services in the Wards, particularly in Umoja I Ward which has only 6 No. staffs
- ii) Measures that the Nairobi Metropolitan Services (NMS) and County Executive is putting in place to distribute litter bins in strategic points in the Wards; and
- iii) Status report on the implementation and uptake of the voluntary early retirement programme that the County was set to roll out for the aged County work force.
