REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Subject: Renaming or Roads in the County

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Transport and Public Works regarding the renaming of roads in the County.

Hon. Speaker, paragraph 5 of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution, 2010 provide for the functions and powers of County Government on County transport including county roads, street lighting, public road transport traffic and parking. The County Assembly has passed several Motions urging the implementing agencies to rename some roads in honour of heroes and heroines who have contributed immensely to the development of the Country.

Hon. Speaker, a road in Kileleshwa Ward has been unprocedurally and unclearly renamed after the Central Organization of Trade Unions (COTU) Kenya Secretary General.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

i. Criteria used to rename Dik Dik Road to Mr. Francis Atwoli Road in Kileleshwa Ward; and

ii. Steps the County Executive is taking to ensure there are regulations in place to be used in naming and renaming of roads and County facilities across the County.
