Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a Statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Labour and Social Welfare regarding the insurance premium of the County Executive Staff.


Hon. Speaker, Article 41 (1) of the Constitution, 2010 provides for every person having the right to fair labour practices which include reasonable working conditions. However, a number of the County Executive Staff have died or admitted in hospitals due to depression caused by the deplorable working standards.

Hon. Speaker, a majority of hard working staff from the County Executive are languishing in poverty due to the depleting working conditions in their work environments which has resulted in endless strikes, corruption and anarchy in the County that has almost stalled the operations of the County Government.

Hon. Speaker, some of these workers have family members to take care of and in order for the County to progress we need to motivate the County Government employees by ensuring their living standards are well taken care off as well as providing a good working condition.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i. Insurance Premium for the County Executive Staff for the financial years 2017/2018 and 2018/2019;
- ii. Detailed claims for inpatients, ID. Number, Man Number and their dependents, where they were admitted and detailed cost breakdown rebates from National Health Insurance Fund (NHIF);
- iii. Outpatient Capitation benefits, Capitation rates and utilization;
- iv. Tender documents issued by procurement department to tenders from the financial years 2017/2018 & 2019;
- v. Awarded bid documents for the successful tenderer; and,
- vi. Scheme of cover from job group A-J paid in the financial years 2017/2018 & 2019.
