REQUEST FOR STATEMENT

(FIRST SESSION)

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of Sectoral Committee on Lands, Planning and Housing regarding alleged grabbing of public land by Kamindi Supermarket in Donholm, Upper Savannah Ward.
