REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,


Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Culture and Community Services regarding mushrooming liquor kiosks within the County especially in the lower part of the Central Business District.

Hon. Speaker, recent months have witnessed increased establishment of unlicensed liquor kiosks in various parts of the County especially in the lower part of the Central Business District such as Latema Road, selling cheaper liquor to people especially youth and street children at night.

Hon. Speaker, the existence of such unlicensed liquor kiosks within the County pose a security threat to the residents and pedestrians in the lower part of the Central Business District.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i) Approval of the establishment of liquor kiosks within the County especially in the lower part of the Central Business District;
- ii) Whether such liquor kiosks are licensed to operate and the time of operation; and
- iii) Measures the County Executive is taking to control/stop the mushrooming of liquor kiosks within the County especially in the lower part of the Central Business District.
