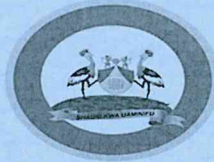

REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Environment and Natural Resources regarding preparedness of the County Government to respond to the effect of climate action change.

Hon. Speaker, the National Government recently passed the Climate Change Act, 2016 of Kenya. The main objective of the Act is the development, management, implementation and regulation of mechanisms to enhance climate change resilience and low carbon development for the sustainable development of Kenya.

Hon. Speaker, currently the Government of Egypt is hosting the 27th Conference of the Parties of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) (Conference of Parties, COP 27), with a view to build on previous successes and paving the way for future ambition to effectively tackle the global challenge of climate change.

Hon. Speaker, it is very important for us as a County to immediately come up with a framework to ensure that we protect our environment from carbon emissions most importantly since the County is densely populated.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i. Whether the County Executive has any plans to come up with a climate change adaption and mitigation policy framework; and
- ii. Measure the County Executive has put in place to regulate or curb emission of green houses in the City.
