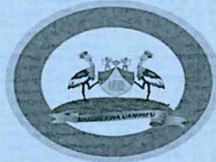

REQUEST FOR STATEMENT

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Labour and Social Services regarding interdiction of staffers serving in the Nairobi County Executive Sector Urban Planning, department of Planning, Compliance and enforcement.

Hon. Speaker, disciplinary control is an integral part of any human resource management in any institution and it's intended to contribute to performance improvement and productivity and should be governed by principles of natural justice


Hon. Speaker, in the last few months Nairobi City County has been greatly affected by some buildings collapsing due to structural issues. There has been a crackdown by the government to apprehend the owners of the said buildings.

Hon. Speaker, the disciplinary process in the Public Service is governed by principles of natural justice that require any officer charged with any offence is given an opportunity to defend himself or herself before an impartial adjudicator as per the policies.

Hon. Speaker, some staff working in the Nairobi County Executive Sector Urban Planning, department of Planning, Compliance and enforcement have been interdicted unfairly due to the collapsing of buildings in the County. In the said department there have been shortage of staffers allocated across the County to undertake inspections visits.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i. Whether the said staffers are the ones who bear the liability when a building collapses;
- ii. Whether due process was followed in the interdiction of the said staffers;
- iii. Steps the County Executive has put in place to ensure that there is adequate human resource in the department of Planning, Compliance and enforcement.
