REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS



Subject: Allegations regarding skewed Payments of Garbage Contractors in the County

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of Sectoral Committee on Environment and Natural Resources regarding outstanding payments to garbage contractors in the County.

Hon. Speaker, Article 42 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 provides every person the right to a clean and healthy environment, which includes the right to have the environment protected for the benefit of present and future generations. To achieve this, the County engages contractors to collect and dispose garbage from across the County. However, there is undue delay in release of payments to these contractors. Further, Hon. Speaker, there are allegations that whenever there is cash flow in the County, these contractors are subject to selective payments despite all of them delivering on their terms.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i) The list of contractors paid during the Financial Year 2021-2022 and those with pending payments;
- ii) Reasons the County Executive has not paid all garbage contractors who have rendered their services to the County; and
- iii) Measures the County Executive is putting in place to ensure County creditors are paid in time.
