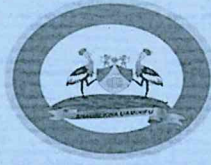

REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Health Services regarding the yellow fever vaccination and vaccine and premises across the County.

Hon. Speaker, it is a requirement by the ministry of Health across most nations worldwide for every person to be vaccinated against yellow fever. It is also a requirement that the vaccination be done at the gazetted health centers and premises.

Hon. Speaker, the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 provides for the right to the highest attainable standard of health including right to health care services. It is unfortunate that Nairobi residents cannot access vaccines including yellow fever at the County Inoculation Centre due to lack of vaccines.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i. The number of gazetted vaccination centers and premises across the County and those that are issuing international travel vaccine certificates;
- ii. Legal framework governing the issuance of vaccine certificates in the County;
- iii. Whether the charges and tariffs leveled are anchored on any law or regulation;
- iv. Whether gazetted vaccination centers and premises generate any revenue to the County and the total annual collection for the past years;
- v. The management and maintenance of the vaccination centers and premises across the County;
- vi. Reasons for delay in supplying the necessary vaccines at the vaccination centers and the Inoculation Centre at City Hall;
- vii. Whether the said Centre have a budget to operate on; and
- viii. Measures the County Executive is taking to ensure the County gazetted vaccination centres and premises are supplied with vaccines and other equipment necessary for seamless operation.
