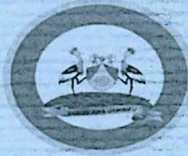


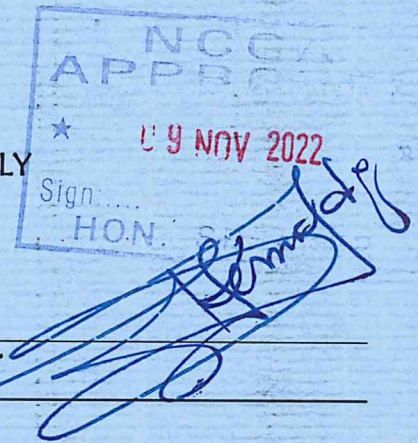

REQUEST FOR STATEMENT

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Transport and Public Works regarding the blockage of Prof. Wangari Mathaai Road.

Hon. Speaker, in the year 2017, the National Assembly passed the National Transport and Safety Authority (NTSA) School Transportation Safety Guidelines. The said guidelines provide among other things that school going children are dropped off and picked up at safe stages to ensure their safety from accidents.

Hon. Speaker, the Premier School located in Nairobi has been causing traffic snarl up especially in early morning and late evening hours due to picking up and dropping off school going children along the Prof. Wangai Mathaai Road. This poses a significant threat to children and other road users.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i. Reasons as to why Premier School has not allocated a drop off and pick up point in the school compound; and
- ii. Whether the County Executive is aware of the said menace and what measures they have put in place to ensure that each school within the County allocates a stage for pick up and drop off.
