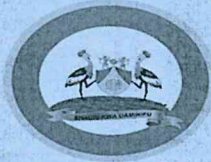

REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Select Committee on County Finance, Budget and Appropriations regarding the revenue collection and management system in the County.

Hon. Speaker, following the expiry of the Deed of Transfer of Functions to the National Government which established the Nairobi Metropolitan Services, where the Kenya Revenue Authority was mandated to collect revenue for the County, the function was reverted back to the County at the end of August, 2022.

Hon. Speaker, the County Government is known to be prone to loss of revenue due to leakages and loopholes in revenue collection and management systems at the County Executive. Accordingly, there is need to develop a robust system that will improve revenue collection and management which should translate to good service delivery to the residents across the County.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

1. The current system the County Executive is using to collect and manage revenue across the County and how much the platform charges in terms of Agency fees;
2. Procedures and factors taken into account on the determination for the relevant current collection platform;
3. The efficiency and effectiveness of the current system used in revenue collection and management since the expiry of the Kenya Revenue Authority contract;
4. Measures the County Executive is taking to seal perennial loopholes and leakages in revenue collection and management across the County
