

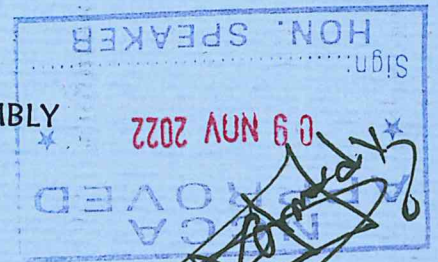

REQUEST FOR STATEMENT

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Transport and Public Works regarding the allocation of pick up and drop off points in the County.

Hon. Speaker, the Nairobi City County Transport Act 25 (1) provides that the County Executive Committee Member shall designate public transport vehicles terminals in the County. Section 27 further provides that a public service vehicle shall only pick up or drop passengers at a designated bus stop.

Hon. Speaker, the data relayed by the National Transport and Safety Authority (NTSA) has revealed that there are only 272 No. of registered Sacco's operating in Nairobi against a figure of 692 No. of Sacco's as indicated by City Hall records. This translates to the high number of illegal drop and pick points in the County, resulting to unnecessary traffic jams in the City.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i. A report on the approved drop and pick up stages in the County ;
- ii. Whether the Matatu Sacco's are compliant with the transport regulations; and
- iii. Plans the County Executive has put in place to curb the rising numbers of illegal pick and drop off points.
