

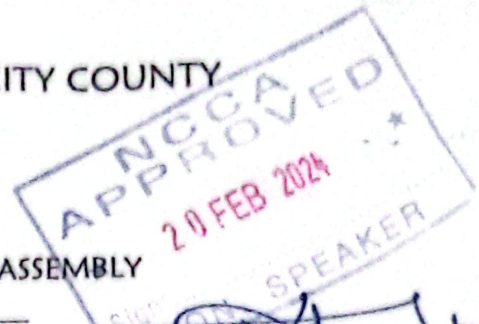

REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Trade, Tourism and Cooperatives regarding the decreasing revenue collected from the markets within the County.

Hon. Speaker, the County recently embarked on allocating considerable amount of monies to renovate some of the public markets across the City.

Hon. Speaker, despite making the said improvements, the County has continued to witness a worrying drop in the revenue being collected from the County Markets.

Hon. Speaker, it is expected that having invested in renovation of the sid markets, then revenue collected should increase due to improved services and new face that the markets offer both to traders and to customers.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i. List of all markets across the County;
- ii. Amount each market generates in terms of revenue to the County;
- iii. Whether payments of these revenue are made in terms of Mpesa or made through County Revenue Fund (CRF) accounts to the County. And if in the accounts, who are the signatories to these accounts and how much is taken to these accounts; and
- iv. Steps that the County is taking to ensure that maximum revenue collection is tapped from these markets.
