REQUEST FOR STATEMENT

SUBJECT: DEFUNCT CITY COUNCIL CITY PRIVILEGE STICKER/CARD

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a Statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Transport, Roads and Public Works regarding the City Privilege sticker/card also known as 'Key to the City".

Hon Speaker, prior to the promulgation of the New Constitution in 2010 which led to devolved governments, there was a City Privilege sticker/card that the mayor could award to public dignitaries, exemplary members of the public service, and other professionals in recognition of outstanding or distinguished services rendered to the nation/city council in various capacities and responsibilities. The holder of a privilege sticker/card could have access to services like free parking, quick access to city hall services etc.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on:-

- 1. Whether the City Privilege sticker/card still exists;
- 2. Whether those holding the City Privilege sticker/card from the defunct City Council can still access the said privileges;
- 3. A detailed list of those holding the City Privilege sticker/card if it is still in use; and
- 4. Steps that the County Executive is taking to ensure that a similar initiative of the Privilege/card sticker can be fully rolled out for public dignitaries, former Members of County Assembly, exemplary members of the public service and other professionals in recognition of outstanding or distinguished services.
