REQUEST FOR STATEMENT

Subject: Awards of tenders in the County

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a Statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Finance Budget and Appropriations regarding awards of tenders in the County.

Hon. Speaker, Article 227 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 requires that public procurement be carried out in a system that is fair, equitable, transparent, competitive and cost-effective. Further, Supplementary Constitutional provisions which ought to be adhered to in public procurement include: the national values (Article 10) of the constitution of Kenya 2010; equality and freedom from discrimination (Article 27); affirmative action programmes (Article 55); principles of Public Finance (Article 201); the values and principles of public service (Article 232); and Chapter 6 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 on Leadership and Integrity.

However, Hon. Speaker, it is alleged that the County Executive awarded contracts to Zeyana, Amical Co. Ltd, Hekari Limited, venture works and Haus of D & P under unclear circumstances.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on:-

- i) Whether the County Executive properly followed the requisite tendering procedure;
- ii) Procurement awards, CR 12, the Companies and the status of payments of the said tenders; and
- iii) Measures the County Executive is taking to curb vices that may come with tender awards going forward.
