Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Transport and Public Works regarding encroachment of road reserves along Ngong road by Moto-Vehicle Sale Yards.

Hon. Speaker, County Governments have been mandated under the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution to manage County transport which include public road transport and protection/maintenance of roads and road reserves.

Hon. Speaker, the law prohibits encroachment of road reserves since road reserves allow for expansion and improvement of roads, ensures clear visibility by drivers/road users and act as buffer zones in case of vehicles veering-off the road. However, Moto Vehicle dealers have encroached road reserves in the City with wanton abandon especially along Ngong Road which they have converted into Moto-Vehicle sale yards.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i.) Who authorized the conversion of Road Reserves along Ngong Road into Moto Vehicle Sale Yards? Provide a list of owners of the sale yards and any agreement with the County Government:
- ii.) What action is the County Government taking to evict Motor Vehicle sale yards which have encroached road reserves along Ngong Road; and

iii.) What control measures has the County Government put in place to safeguard road reserves across the city.
