Subject: Operations and Equipping of Pumwani Dispensary

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a Statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Health Services regarding operationalization of Pumwani Dispensary in Pumwani Ward.

Hon. Speaker, the County is mandated to manage the County health services including county health facilities and pharmacies and promotion of primary health care, pursuant to the provisions of paragraph two of Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution of Kenya 2010.

Hon. Speaker, the construction of Pumwani Dispensary was completed in December, 2023. However, the operationalization of the health facility has stalled due to lack of the necessary equipment for its operations. The facility is not limited to provide health services only to the residents of Pumwani Ward, but to any patient from across the County.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- 1. Whether the County Executive has allocated a budget for equipping and operationalization of Pumwani Dispensary;
- 2. Measures the County Executive is taking to ensure the health facility is fully equipped and in operation including posting of required personnel; and
- 3. Date when the Facility is expected to commence operations.
