REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Subject: Stalled Public Toilet In Ngei Ward

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a Statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Water and Sanitation regarding the stalled construction of public toilet in Ngei Ward.

Hon. Speaker, Article 41 (1) (b) of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 provides for the right of every person to reasonable standards of sanitation.

Hon. Speaker, in bid to implement the aforementioned Article, the County Government under the Directorate of Water and Sanitation in 2013 commenced construction of public toilet in Ngei Ward which was to benefit the residents in the Ward.

Hon. Speaker, the structure of the said facility was completed. However, the drainage was not completed and thus stalled. This matter has been raised by the relevant department but to date nothing has happened. The structure has been turned into a store by unknown persons.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

1. Reasons for the delay to complete the public toilet to benefit the residents of Ngei Ward;
2. Measures the County Executive is taking to ensure the public toilet in Ngei Ward is completed and in operation.
