Petrol Stations constructed without entry and exit points

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a Statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Roads, Transport and Public Works regarding the safety and compliance status of Ravi and Autogas petrol stations operating without designated entry and exit points within Ngara and Lower Savannah Wards respectively.

Hon. Speaker, Section 92 of the Petroleum Act, 2019, provides that all petroleum infrastructure must meet the safety, technical, and operational standards set by the Energy and Petroleum Regulatory Authority (EPRA). Additionally, Part IV of the Kenya Roads Act, 2007 which regulates access to classified roads requires entry and exit designs for developments adjoining such roads.

Hon. Speaker, the two petrol stations lack properly defined entry and exit lanes, thereby compromising road safety, impeding traffic flow, and violating both National and County Laws that regulate the establishment and operation of petroleum retail outlets.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- 1. Detailed report clarifying whether the two petrol stations were approved in accordance with Section 92 of the Petroleum Act, 2019, which mandates that all petroleum infrastructure must meet the safety, technical, and operational standards set by the Energy and Petroleum Regulatory Authority (EPRA);
- 2. Measures the County Executive has put in place to ensure the said petrol stations comply with County Urban Planning and road safety Policies; and
- 3. Provide timeline and a corrective action plan to ensure that all petrol stations operating in Nairobi County install clearly marked and functional entry and exit points, in line with national safety standards.
