REQUEST FOR STATEMENT

Subject: The alleged unfair recruitment in the County and specifically recruitment of Green Army Constables.

Hon. Speaker, Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a Statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Labour and Social Welfare regarding the alleged unfair recruitment in the County and Specifically recruitment of Green Army and Constables.

Hon. Speaker, Article 41 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 with regard to Labor Relations specifies on the right to fair labor practices including recruitment and non – discrimination.

Further, Labor laws are a set of laws, regulations, and standards that govern the rights and obligations of employers and employees in all walks of life in terms of protecting the rights and interests of workers and ensuring that they are treated fairly and with respect.

As part of developing a more human work culture, fairness is a key element that ought to be looked at keenly while recruiting.

Hon. Speaker, it is alleged that recruitment of youth under Green Army and constables in the County was done unfairly as only (4) youths were recruited from Roysambu Ward.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on:-

- i) State the number of beneficiaries/employed youth under Green Army and Constables in Roysambu Ward, specific area of resident and their specific contacts and Identification Numbers (ID); and
- ii) Measures the County Executive has put in place to ensure compliance with Article. 41 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 and Labour related laws with regard to fairness during recruitment.
