

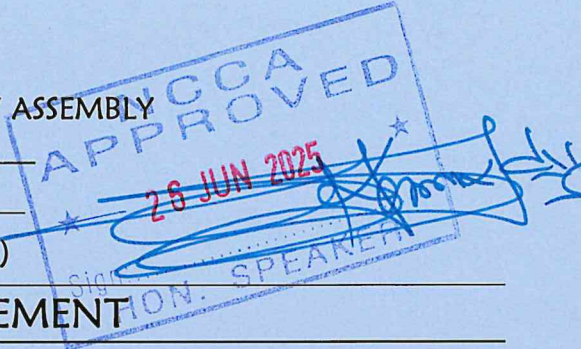

**REQUEST FOR STATEMENT**

**Subject: Cleaning and Garbage Collection in the County especially Lindi Ward**

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a Statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Environment and Natural Resources regarding cleaning and garbage collection within the County, especially in Lindi Ward.

Hon. Speaker, Article 42 of the Constitution 2010 provides for the right of every person to a clean and healthy environment, which includes the right to have the environment protected for the benefit of present and future generations through legislative and other measures. Further Article 43 (1) provides for the right of every person to the highest attainable standard of health.

Hon. Speaker, the people of Lindi Ward are undergoing both environmental and health challenges due to uncollected garbage in the Ward. The poor waste management in Lindi Ward has led to water and air pollution, disease outbreaks, and habitat destruction.

Hon. Speaker, my efforts to address the matter with the responsible authorities at the Ward and Sub-County levels has not bore any fruit despite having a garbage truck working within Kibra Sub-County.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

1. Criteria used by the County Executive in collection and dumping of garbage across all Wards within the County;
2. Person(s) responsible for garbage collection within Kibra Sub-County; and
3. Measures the County Executive is taking to ensure prompt cleaning and garbage collection in Lindi Ward for resident to have a clean and healthy environment.
