REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Subject: LapFund massive contribution shortfall caused by county government's failure to remit deducted funds to the scheme and delayed disbursement to retirees.

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a Statement from the Chairperson of the Select Committee on County Finance, Budget and Appropriations regarding LapFund massive contribution shortfall caused by county government's failure to remit deducted funds to the scheme and delayed disbursement to retirees.

Hon. Speaker, cases of retirees enduring long and frustrating period following up on the processing and disbursement of the rightful retirement dues after active service is still on the rise. It is emerging that a number of retirees have since passed on waiting, while some in the hospital beds, incapacitated, transferring the agony and frustration to their next of kin. This shows the great need to streamline the processes of remission and reimbursement both from the County Executive and Lapfund pension scheme.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on:-

- i) Details of the amount the County Executive has remitted to Lapfund for the last 4 years;
- ii) Details of the remittance schedule to the retirees for the last 4 years detailing the remittance turn-around time from the point of process initiation and funds disbursement;
- iii) Details of the pending remission by the County Executive to Lapfund and reasons for such delay, if any;
- iv) Nature of the investment ventures executed by Lapfund using Member's pension including the return on investment for such projects; and,
- v) Details on the interest on investment and benefit to fund members for the last 4 years.
