REQUEST FOR STATEMENT

Subject: Management of Marurui Health Centre

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a Statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Health Services regarding the management of the Marurui Health Centre.

Hon. Speaker, the County Government is mandated to manage the County health facilities pursuant to the provision of paragraph two of Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution of Kenya 2010. The County Executive oversees the day to day management and operations of County Health facilities in the City.

Hon. Speaker, the construction of a perimeter wall around Marurui Health centre first appeared in the Budget Estimates of the FY 2019/2020 and to date, the wall has not been constructed as the project continues to appear in subsequent years budgets.

Hon. Speaker, a great concern has been raised by residents of Roysambu Ward over the running and management of the Marurui health centre. Article 35 of the Constitution of Kenya (2010) grants the right to request and access information.

Hon Speaker, I have received reports that the health facility is being run down by an incompetent management currently in place. It is not clear how the management of the facility has spent the revenues received from SHA in the FY 2025/26.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i. The current composition of the management board members and their qualifications;
- ii. When the management board was appointed and what the terms of appointment are (Kindly attach the appointment letters);
- iii. The amount of revenue SHA has paid into the facility in the FY 2025/26; and
- iv. How the funds received from SHA have been utilized.
