REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS


Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2)(c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Environment and Natural Resources regarding piled up garbage waste besides Ngong river, along the Embakasi – Soweto bridge in Lower Savanna Ward.

Hon. Speaker, the garbage heap has been accumulating at the riverbank since the beginning of the year. This has not only toxified the river, but also posed a serious health hazard to the residents of Lower Savannah Ward and its environs.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on:-

- i) Why the County Government has not been collecting waste along and around the said river-bank since the beginning of the year; and,
- ii) What measures have been taken by the County Executive to address the matter in order to end the dumping of garbage along the river-bank.
