**4. NOTICES OF MOTION – (HON. KABIRO MBUGUA, MCA)**

**THAT**, aware that Chapter Four of the Constitution 2010 provides for the Bill of Rights which is an integral part of Kenya's Democratic state and is the framework for social, economic and cultural policies; further aware that the purpose of recognising and protecting human rights and fundamental freedoms is to preserve the dignity of individuals and communities and to promote social justice and the realization of the potentials of all human beings; acknowledging that the Country has since independence named and renamed streets, roads among other public places to honour heroes and heroines who have contributed immensely to the development of the Republic; noting that the naming of public places after
