1. The Assembly assembled at thirty minutes past Two O'clock.
2. The Proceedings were opened with Prayer

QUORUM OF THE ASSEMBLY

The presiding Chair (Hon Anthony Kimemia, MCA) having confirmed that there was no Quorum caused the Bell to be rung for Ten minutes.

There being no Quorum at the expiry of the ten minutes, the presiding Chair caused the bell to be rung again for five minutes.

And there being a Quorum at the expiry of the five minutes, the Presiding Speaker called the Assembly to order.

3. NOTICE OF MOTION - (Hon. Silas Matara, MCA)

THAT, aware that under the Article 186 (1) of the Constitution of Kenya, and Fourth Schedule, the functions and powers of County Government, among others, covers County transport including county roads, street lighting, public road transport traffic and parking; further aware that the City has designated preferential bus stops throughout the City County roads; noting that recent years have witnessed a marked increase in the number of public service vehicles plying various routes in the County; concerned that most pedestrian walkways and unmarked bus-stop areas along various County roads have been illegally turned into bus stops for picking and dropping of passengers by not only the public services vehicles but also private vehicles, this has led to increased traffic congestion and accidents including deaths to pedestrians; further noting that the allocation of parking, picking and dropping zones for public service vehicles was last done in the year 2000, this Assembly urges the County Executive to increase the picking and

dropping areas in the County roads and rehabilitate the existing ones with adequate passenger waiting cabins.
