Subject: guidelines for secondment and/or deployment of public officers

Motion moved and question proposed

THAT, aware that Article 187 of the Constitution, 2010 and Section 24 of the Intergovernmental Relations Act, 2012 provides for the transfer of

functions and powers from one level of Government to another; **further** aware that on 25th February, 2020, the Governor signed a memorandum transferring some of the County Government functions such as health services, transport services, county planning and development services and public works to the National Government as provided for in the Constitution which took effect from 17th March, 2020 and for twenty-four (24) months subject to renewal; **acknowledging** that in execution of the Transfer Deed, His Excellence the President established the Nairobi Metropolitan Services Office to spearhead the implementation of the transferred functions; **recognizing** that there has been a rift between the County Executive and the Nairobi Metropolitan Services on various issues such as process of secondment and/or deployment of public officers from the County Executive to Nairobi Metropolitan Services; **noting** that Article 187 (2) (b) of the Constitution provides that constitutional responsibility for performance of the function or exercise of power on transferred functions shall remain with the government to which it is assigned by the Fourth Schedule, this Assembly urges the County Executive in conjunction with the Nairobi Metropolitan Services to develop guidelines for approval by the County Assembly on the secondment and/or deployment of officers from the County Government to the Nairobi Metropolitan Service to enhance seamless service delivery to the residents of Nairobi City County.
