**The Nairobi City County Food Safety and Fortification Bill, 2022
(Assembly Bill No.3 of 2022)**

THAT Clause 6 of the Bill be amended as follows;

- (i) In sub-clause (1) by inserting the following new paragraphs immediately after paragraph (d);
 - a. **(da)** oversee the management and development of vocational education staff through the TVET.
 - b. **(db)** Develop and expand by equipping the TVET's centres to ensure access to quality affordable appropriate and relevant technical industrial vocational training.
 - c. **(dc)** Coordinate with Governor's office and develop partners in the county to facilitate youth training and empowerment partners in the county to facilitate youth training and empowerment.
 - d. **(dd)** Coordinate with national government for implementation of training programmes certification.
 - e. **(de)** Formulate a county Technical Vocational Education and Training Strategic Development Plan
 - f. **(df)** Promote training and progressive development under the Vocational Training Centres and similar

 - b. **(hb)** receiving fees, grants, subscriptions, donations, bequests or other monies and to make disbursement to the institutions or other bodies or persons;
 - c. **(hc)** determine fees payable and prescription conditions under which fees may be remitted in part or in whole in accordance with guidelines developed under the provisions of TVET Act, 2013.
 - d. **(hd)** mobilise resources for the Vocational training centers'
 - e. **(he)** make regulations governing organizing, conduct and discipline of the staff and students
 - f. **(hf)** provide for the welfare of the students and staff of the vocational training centers;

- (i) In sub-clause (1) by deleting paragraph(s) (a) and (i) in their entirety.
- (ii) In Sub-clause (2) by deleting the sub-clause in its entirety and substituting thereof the following-

“Membership of the Council shall not exceed two-thirds of the same gender in accordance with Article 27 (8) of the Constitution”.

- (iii) In Sub-clause (3) by deleting the term “further” appearing immediately after the words “for a” and substituting thereof the word “final”.

- (iv) By inserting a new sub-clause as follows-

(3a) “Quorum of the council and/or Board of directors shall be at-least two-thirds of the membership.
