THIRD ASSEMBLY - (THIRD SESSION) NAIROBI CITY COUNTY ASSEMBLY VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS WEDNESDAY, APRIL 17, 2024 AT 2.30PM

The Speaker (Hon. Kennedy Ng'ondi) having confirmed that there was a Quorum at the commencement of the Assembly called the Assembly to order.

3. COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR

The Speaker issued the following communication: -

RECONSTITUTION OF COMMITTEES

"Hon. Members, I have the following communication to convey; -

Hon. Members, the County Assembly Committees are extensions of the Assembly established under the County Assembly Standing Orders and in accordance with Section 14 of the County Governments Act, 2012. The Committees are supposed to perform functions that the Assembly is not well fitted to consider in plenary.

Hon. Members, Standing Order 203 (4) provide that the County Public Accounts Committee constituted immediately following the general election shall serve for a period of three calendar years and that constituted thereafter shall serve for the remainder of the County Assembly term.

Hon. Members, further Standing Order 209 (3) provides that a member appointed to a Sectoral Committee at the commencement of a County Assembly shall serve for three sessions and the Committee shall thereafter be reconstituted, to serve for

the remainder of the term of that County Assembly.

Hon. Members, the Committees being an extension of the County Assembly are supposed to perform functions on behalf the County Assembly effectively and efficiently for the betterment of the Assembly and the County at large.

Hon. Members, to ensure effectiveness and efficiency in performance of the County Assembly and its Committees and pursuant the provisions of Standing Order 1 and notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 203 and 209 respectively, I direct for the reconstitution of the Select Committee on Public Accounts and Sectoral Committee on Water and Sanitation pursuant to the provisions of Standing Orders 168(2) and 171(1).
