ADDRESS BY H.E. THE GOVERNOR

“Your Excellency, Hon. Members, invited guests, you may now take your seats.

Your Excellency, Hon. Sakaja Johnson Arthur, the Governor of Nairobi City County, Hon. Members of the County Assembly and distinguished guests, Section 31 (k) of the County Governments Act, 2012 requires the Governor to deliver an annual state of the county address containing such matters as may be specified in county legislation. Further, Standing Order 25 of the Nairobi City County Assembly Standing Orders provides that the Governor shall address a special sitting of County Assembly once every year and may address the County Assembly at any other time.

In this regard, therefore, pursuant to Section 30(1) (k) of the County Governments Act, 2012, H.E. the Governor vide a letter referenced Ref. NCC/GOV/27/2024 dated 20th March, 2024 informed my office on his intention to address the County Assembly on 28th March, 2024. However, upon further consultation with the House leadership coupled with the

short recess, we agreed that H.E. the Governor delivers his address today Thursday, 4th April, 2024.

Consequently, pursuant to Standing Order 25 (2), I gave notice of today's sitting to Hon. Members and the general public by Gazette Notice No. 3934 which was published in the *Kenya Gazette* on Wednesday 3rd April, 2024.
