5. NOTICES OF MOTION - NAMING OF SIFA SPRING ESTATE ACCESS ROAD FROM FIVE STAR T-INTERSECTION ROAD AS MUMZY ROAD

THAT, aware that paragraph 5 (c) of Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 provides for County Transport, including but not limited to County Roads as a County Government function; **FURTHER AWARE** that clause 3.3 of the Nairobi City County Property, Addressing and Street Naming Policy under Sessional Paper No. 2 of 2021 provides for the general guidelines for street and road naming, and on the selection of such names which requires to be inter-alia of good character and must meet the threshold set by Chapter 6 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010; **ACKNOWLEDGING** that road naming is critical for the provision of emergency services and essential in the delivery of other services to the properties in the street; APPRECIATING the great contribution of Chief Abdinoor Gessey Mumzy who served as a paramount chief of Mandera in 1959 during the British colonial era; **NOTING** that current new access road linking Sifa Spring Estate from the Five Star T-Intersection Road in South C Ward remains un-named posing navigation challenge and the need to honor such historic community leaders; this ASSEMBLY URGES the County Executive through the County Addressing Unit to name the Sifa Spring Estate access road from Five Star T-Intersection road as MUMZY ROAD in honor of the 1959 paramount Chief, Abdinoor Gessey Mumzy.
