The Speaker issued the following Message from the Governor;

NOMINATION OF MEMBERS TO THE NAIROBI CITY COUNTY AFFORDABLE HOUSING COMMITTEE

"Hon. Members, I have received communication from the Governor on the nomination to the Nairobi City County Urban Affordable Housing Committee.

'Hon. Members, in accordance with the Affordable Housing Act, 2024, Section 34, it is with great confidence that I announce the appointment of Members to the Nairobi City County Affordable Housing Committee.

This Committee is mandated to guide the strategic implementation, coordination and oversight of affordable housing initiatives across the County to ensure they align with County policies and public interests. I hereby nominate Mr. Chris

Abuga of ID No: 25242022, to be vetted by the Nairobi County Assembly to serve as a Non-Executive Chairperson to the Committee.

The purpose and scope of the Nairobi City County Affordable Housing Committee is to: -

- 1. Overseeing affordable housing projects, programmes and initiatives in line with the 2024 Act;
- 2. Advising on policy matters, funding and partnership to expand affordable housing opportunities;
- 3. Monitoring compliance with established guidelines to ensure the safety, suitability ad accessibility of affordable housing projects;
- 4. Engaging stakeholders including private and public sector representatives to foster collaboration and resource sharing;
- 5. Reporting progress, challenges and recommendations to the office of the Governor, and enhance County affordable agenda.

Each member is entrusted to uphold the mandate of the Committee by bringing their expertise, commitment and insight to fulfil the affordable vision for Nairobi County.

Duration and accountability: The tenure of these appointments shall run for a period of 3 years from the effective date, with a midterm review to access the Committee's progress and effectiveness in meeting set objectives. All members shall report to the Chairperson and submit periodic reports to the office of the Governor.

I have confidence that the combined expertise and dedication of this team will significantly impact Nairobi County housing landscape, helping us realize a more inclusive and affordable

future for all residence."
