3. NOTICE OF MOTION - HON. WAITHERA CHEGE, MCA SUBJECT - RENAMING OF A COUNTY ROAD AFTER PHEROZE NOWROJEE

The following notice of motion was given; -

AWARE that Article 186 (1) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 and Paragraph 5 of Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution provide for transport including County roads, street lighting, public road transport traffic, and parking as a devolved county function; **FURTHER AWARE** that the country has since independence named and renamed roads and other public facilities in honor of heroes and heroines who have contributed immensely in the society as a way of honoring them; **APPRECIATING** the late

Pheroze Nowrojee SC, who was a distinguished and patriotic Kenyan lawyer, human rights defender, a poet, historian and patriot, who made indelible contributions to the Nation through his dedicated service and deep commitment to justice, human dignity, and the rule of law. His early legal training in Kenya and later years in India, United Kingdom and the United States of America gave him a unique blend of local understanding and global perspective, that informed his work throughout his life. He was a kind of advocate who pursued justice over grandstanding and or profit, often offering his services pro-bono whenever the occasion so required, and who believed in the sanctity of the Constitution, even in the most turbulent political climates; **IN ACKNOWLEDGING** some of the immense contributions by Senior Counsel Pheroze Nowrojee, in 1995, the Kenyan section of the International Commission of Jurists (ICJ Kenya) awarded him the Jurist of the Year, a recognition reserved for individuals who hkave demonstrated exceptional commitment to the protection and promotion of human rights, justice, and the rule of law. SC Pheroze Nowrojee, was also recognized by the International Bar Association in 1995, he received the Bernard Simons Human Rights prize for 2002-2004, the Law Society Roll of Honor 2005, the Maasai People Safeguarding Rights Award 2007, the CB Madan Constitutional prize 2014. He was a distinguished lecturer in the University of Dar salaam, University of Nairobi and Kenya school of law. He was a distinguished scholar and author of many books among them; A vote for Kenya, The Elections and the Constitution 2013, and A Kenyan Journey, 2014, among others; **RECOGNIZING** that County established a County Policy on property addressing and street naming which provides for procedures that should be undertaken in relation to address management functions, such as address selection and naming of roads and streets within the County, FURTHER **APPRECIATING** that by renaming of a prominent road in Nairobi would serve as a fitting tribute to his lasting legacy and ensure that his contributions are remembered and celebrated by future generations; THIS ASSEMBLY **THEREFORE URGES** the County Executive to rename a County road after the late Senior Counsel Pheroze Nowrojee in recognition of not only his patriotism, excellent contribution to the rule of law, human rights and democracy and generally good governance in the Republic of Kenya, but also
