6. ALLOWING HAWKERS TO CARRY ON THEIR BUSINESS IN DESIGNATED AREAS.

Motion made and Question proposed –

THAT, aware that recent years have witnessed a marked increase in the number of hawkers in the Nairobi City County Business District (CBD) and its environs; further aware that there has been a problem between hawkers and licensed rent-paying business entities who compete for the limited space available within the CBD and its environs; deeply concerned that the way hawkers are treated by the City County Inspectorate and enforcement is wanting; noting that these hawkers are Kenyan youth and women who try to earn a living by hawking due to unemployment which is a nightmare for both the National and the County Governments, this Assembly urges the County Government to create a framework to ensure a balance between the interests of the licensed rent-paying entities and hawkers who get their daily bread from hawking by allowing hawkers to use designated areas within the CBD to carry out their businesses within a specific time in order to avoid running battles with the City County Inspectorate Department.
