WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 14, 2015

1. The House assembled at twenty minutes to Three O'clock.

3. NOTICE OF MOTION – (Hon. Peter Imwatok, MCA)

The following notice of motion was given:

THAT, aware that the 2014/2015 budget was passed and included allocations for capital projects, including the Wards Development Fund; deeply concerned that despite the allocation the said capital projects have suffered slowed implementation by the County Executive and thus hindered the delivery of services to Nairobi residents; noting that the biggest impediment to implementation of projects, including Wards Development Fund projects, remains endless delays in the procurement function; realizing that there are numerous incomplete projects from the preceding financial years that are yet to be completed, while the Assembly has moved ahead to allocate additional monies for FY 2015/2016, this Assembly resolves that the County Executive move with speed to implement all pending or incomplete projects from FY 2014/15 within the next 90 days and report back to the Assembly on progress regarding the same at the lapse of the said period.
