“Honorable Members, during consideration of the 2015/2016 Budget, the Select Committee on Water and Sanitation factored the sum of Kshs3 million as funds for water related projects in each Ward across the City.

In order to utilize the said allocation, the Assembly Sectoral Committee on Water and Sanitation is requesting Members to forward projects pertaining to water and sanitation from each of the 85 elective Ward in Nairobi. .
