3. **COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR**

The Speaker conveyed the following Communication –

“Hon. Members, first I would like to recognize the presence of the Members from Kampala Capital City Authority, Kawempe City Hall. You are most welcome.

Hon. Members, you recall that this Assembly on Thursday 23rd of October 2014 passed a Motion pursuant to section 140 and 142 of the Finance Management Act 2012 authorizing the Nairobi City County Executive Committee Member for Finance to borrow a sum of Kshs. 1.5 billion as a revolving overdraft to cater for the County monthly personnel bills and to borrow the sum of Ksh. 2.5 billion to cater for capital projects for the Financial Year 2014/2015 all amounting to Kshs. 4 billion. Hon. Members, the office of the Speaker recently received a letter from the County Executive Committee Member for Finance and Planning dated 28th January 2015 where reference was made to the other letter dated 22nd October, 2014 by which the request for borrowing has been made. In the 28th January 2015 letter, the County Executive Committee Member for Finance relayed that the Nairobi City County Executive Committee had resolved to request the County Assembly to rescind (or reserve) its approval of the CEC’s earlier request for borrowing in order to allow for further consultation with various stakeholders involved in the matter before the request can be brought afresh before the Assembly for consideration.

Hon. Members, in light of the foregoing request, I direct that the matter be forwarded to the Budget and Appropriation Committee for

deliberation. The committee should report back on the matter on Thursday. The committee should report on Thursday 26th February 2015. It is so directed.
